## **Program**

Helen Kelley introduced our speaker, **Chad Hoffman-Fragale**, **Vice President of Human Resources at Finger Lakes Health**. Chad presented an overview on the COVID vaccine as it pertains to Finger Lakes Health.

- Three types of vaccine:
  - Moderna for ages 18 and older
  - o Pfizer for ages 12 and older
  - o Johnson and Johnson for ages 18 and older
- FLH started giving vaccines on 12/22/2020
- 75% of FLH employees are vaccinated and all employees are encouraged to receive the vaccine.
- The first community clinic was held on 12/28/2020 for the first dose of the Moderna vaccine.
- 4,411 vaccines have have been administered to date.
- The vaccine is also being offered to long-term care patients.
- Masks are still being warn in all healthcare facilities.

On another subject, Chad reviewed some Human Resources initiatives:

- Currently recruiting RN's, LPN's and Medical Technologists
- CNA Training program is being offered at no cost
