Jerry Forcier introduced **District Governor, Linda Kohl and Past District Governor, Dave Hannan** who presented the following Citations to our Club:

• Past President Mary Lawthers, who was President 2019-2020, accepted the Rotary Citation (formerly known as the Presidential Citation) to the Rotary Club of Geneva with <u>Platinum Distinction</u>.

As Dave Hannan pointed out, this is recognition for the Rotary Foundation to "End Polio Now" through "Polio Plus". Since 1985, Rotary has taken on the project of eradicating polio (over 350,000 cases) the last one being January 27, 2021 in Pakistan. Afghanistan's last case was reported as of January 1, 2021, although it is not yet polio-free. Rotary is still able to deliver the vaccine to third world countries.

• The second Rotary Citation was presented by Linda Kohl to Past President Dave Cook who was President 2020-2021.

Dave asked John Oughterson to join him at the podium to thank him for his service to the Club and Interact. Johnny noted that this year's goals include fundraising as well as other service projects.

Both Mary and Dave thanked the entire Club for their dedication.
