### Program

**Tiffany Worboys**, case manager at **Safe Harbors of the FLX**, was today’s presenter. Safe Harbors serves Yates, Seneca, and Ontario counties with “free, immediate, confidential support for victims of all forms of sexual assault/abuse, domestic violence, human trafficking, and child abuse” in the above mentioned three counties. Some of you might recall a past speaker from SH a few years ago who said that a shelter was in the works to be located in Seneca County. The funding for that same shelter was pulled back during COVID but has since been re-released, allowing work on the Seneca County shelter to be nearing completion.

Tiffany outlined some of the services provided and the needs within our communities for donations, including cash, gift cards, clothing, toiletries, and household items for men, women, and children. The local Zonta Club assists SH in sorting clothing and other donations.

Tiffany indicated that incidents of abuse, etc, wane at certain times of the year but definitely rise following major holidays. Her office is located in Franklin Square with about 25 employees. The Penn Yan office is much smaller and the Canandaigua office somewhere in between.

The soon to be completed Seneca County shelter will have nine beds. SH's long term goal is to have a shelter in every county of the state.
