Special Presentation by District Governor

District Governor Brandt presented Ray Ciancaglini with Rotary International's Avenues of Service Award for Community Service. Founder of the Second Impact Foundation, Ray is a renowned concussion awareness advocate. Each year he raises money for special needs children's organizations. In 2022 he organized an "honor your role model night" at McDonough Park and two fundraising banquets for first responders in Geneva.

Dave Cook presented the Club with banners from Rotary Clubs in Georgia, Armenia, and Belarus. Clubs included Yerevan and Gyumri, Armenia; Blisi, Georgia; and Minsk Belarus.

Programs

Debra Rose (National and Rochester Task Force for the 2024 Eclipse) and Debbie Farrell (Geneva Taskforce) shared information about the 2024 Eclipse

- On Monday, April 8, 2024, at 3:20 pm there will be a total eclipse of the sun and Geneva is in the path of totality.
- Totality for Geneva will be between 3:21 and 3:23 pm
- An eclipse occurs when the Moon passes between the Sun and Earth blocking all or part of the Sun. During a total eclipse the Sun is completely covered by the Moon for a short time.

- In 2017 people flocked to areas of the United States where it would be the best to view the eclipse and it could be the same for the Geneva and the Finger Lakes.
- In 2024 New York State is one of 11 states that will be in the path of totality.
- A national taskforce began work five years ago to help prepare cities and regions that are in the path of totality. There is a Rochester task force and Geneva has recently created one.
- As one of the prime locations in the Finger Lakes to experience the total eclipse, this is a unique opportunity to welcome visitors to Geneva
- There are also challenges temperature fluctuations, 49% chance of cloud cover; traffic coming from east and the south (north and west is already in the path of totality); limited outdoor recreation options in early April, and kids getting out of school at the same time as the eclipse.
- Geneva Taskforce is planning Embrace the Dark (a three-day festival from April 6-8)
