#### **Program**

Diana Perry introduced Cheryl Toor, the Director of <u>The Center for Concern</u>. She gave an overview of the Center and its current activities.

- The Center has been serving the community for over 50 years. How they serve the community has changed from "here's your bag" to "what do you need."
- One full-time employee with one part-time employee and 55 volunteers
- In 2022
  - 4,970 families received emergency food from the Food Pantry (up 10% from 2021 and up 40% since the start of the pandemic)
  - Gave 9 scholarships

- Served over 700 people (including 235 families) through Operation Merry Christmas
- Programs
  - The Food Pantry is open Monday -Friday from 10 am to 1 pm.
     Emergency food is distributed twice a month and there is a free table.
  - The Thrift Store is open Monday Friday from 10 am to 3 pm and Saturday 10 am to 12:30 pm
  - Operation Merry Christmas In addition to food distribution (a box based on family size), parents can shop at the North Pole Store
- While the store closed for several months during the pandemic, the food pantry has never closed. A positive result of the pandemic has been the increase in monetary donations.
- New building addition Thanks to donations, grants and proceeds from the 50<sup>th</sup>
   Anniversary celebration 100 sq ft is being added onto the food pantry. The new
   addition will make the food pantry wider creating an intake space, waiting area, a
   permanent spot for meeting, and the ability to enter through one door and exit
   through another.
