Program

Rotarian Ray Defendorf presented information about the **SOYODI Global Grant** for his Corning Club. This grant centers around a youth development initiative in Uganda. It especially targets young women who must often drop out of school for societal reasons and therefore be excluded from furthering their education. It focuses on teaching vocational skills to unemployed youth..The goal is \$63k for the first year. A successful grant will create a micro business where participants will produce reusable sanitary products as well as learn sewing skills, including tailoring, as a vocation. Each graduate will receive a sewing machine, materials and the knowledge needed to support oneself.

All Rotarians are invited to sponsor a Sewing Machine Kit which will then become a permanent source of income for the student and her family. One full sponsorship (one kit) is \$180. A shared Sponsorship of one kit: \$90. Donations are happily accepted. Pledges will be invoiced once the Global Grant is fully funded and approved.
