Program

Dave Cook and his travel partner, **Owen Perry**, presented a slide program with highlights of their recent trip to Germany where Rotarian Vitale, who is in charge of such programs for Rotary, hosted them on a grand tour of parts of Germany and Prague in the Czech Republic. Highlights were the auto factories, museums, and showrooms for BMW, Mercedes-Benz, Porsche, the Prague Museum of History, the Nuremberg Courtroom, Apple Streudel, Jagermeister, a winery tour with tasting, beer tasting, Olympic Stadium, a castle in Bavaria, a cannabis shop, the McDonald's arches sighting, the Museum of Zeppelins, a hospice facility, and more. The language barrier was more evident in Prague, as one would expect, but Germans were very open to communicating and much more prompt than Americans for sure. Dave was impressed by the inclusiveness for special needs residents.

Dave reminded us that these international programs are open to Rotarians and that the estimated cost for a two week trip is \$3000.
