Geneva Rotary applied for a District Grant to buy materials and build up to 6 new picnic tables for Camp ONSEYAWA this summer. The grant was approved. So now we can start to seek any volunteers (friends and family members) who may be interested in working on this service project. The initial thoughts were to measure, pre-cut, and pre-drill holes in Geneva, and then bring everything to camp to assemble. Any carpenter skills appreciated! This is the approximately the style below of what we'll be building for Campers! No dates have been set yet – we just wanted to gather some talented volunteers and try to find a space (garage, barn, or business) that we could gather. Ideally we'd like to build and deliver before Camp Onseyawa runs this summer starting on August 10th.
