Thomas Millington, Executive Director of Abroadia gave an excellent presentation on "Taking Study Abroad to New Frontiers in Cuba and South America". Tonight's focus was on Cuba and the hardships it is enduring.

- Over 30,000 Cubans immigrate to the U.S. every month!
- As of February 2024, the cost of fuel was up 500%
- Cuba remains on the State sponsored terrorism list.
- More than 850,000 Cubans have arrived in the U.S. since 2022. (Legally!)
- They are in extreme poverty and need financial assistance. We can have food delivered through the website Supermarket23.com
- Also monetary contributions are welcomed.

Thank you for having me at tonight's Rotary Club meeting. I enjoyed talking with everyone. Attached is my PowerPoint presentation. For those who would like to learn more about Cuba and its relationship with the United States, I recommend two books:

<u>Cuba: An American History</u> by Ada Ferrer-this traces the role the US played in large parts of Cuban history. <u>That Infernal Little Cuban Republic</u>, by Lars Schoutz-this thoroughly researched book analyzes US policy toward Cuba in the 20th and 21st centuries.

Both books are available at the Geneva Public Library.
