Program

Dr. Kristin Baltazar presented a program about understanding breast cancer. Highlights from her talk –

- 1 out of 8 women will be diagnosed with breast cancer
- 16,700 new diagnoses per year in New York State
- Risk factors – being a woman, aging, family history, race, hormones (early menstruation, late menopause, no children, late first pregnancy, hormone replacement therapy), obesity, smoking, alcohol, and environment
- 21 genes are connected to breast cancer
- Early detection = better survival rate
- Detection – self exam, mammogram, screening MRI
- Treatments are individualized and may include surgery, chemo, radiation, hormonal therapy
