- Nutrition Community dining and delivered meals
- In Home Services home health aides, fees based on income
- Call Buttons goes to call center or to 911 if contact is not made with the resident
- Home Modification Program grab bars, ramps, etc
- Healthy Activity Programs chair yoga, Tai Chi, Balance Classes, Computers and technology
- Medicare Counseling
- Caregiver Respite and Counseling
- Legal Services Healthcare proxies, powers of attorney, Wills, Tenants Rights
- Transportation Assistance
- Volunteer opportunities: drivers, Advisory Council (meets 6X/year)
