Program

SA Captain Manny Sulca was introduced by Rotarian and board member Santa Abraham. Captain Manny is "new" to Geneva, having arrived in July from the Albany area. He is a native of Peru and completed five years of nursing school there, serving in military hospitals. He is a Queens native and has been involved in the Salvation Army since childhood. He is especially dedicated to strong music education programs for kids.

The Geneva SA is located at 481 North Street and is both a church and a community center. Its mission, as part of the Universal Christian Church, is to preach the Bible without discrimination. It embraces all cultures and ethnicities.

Bi-lingual church service is held at 11:15am every Sunday with a strong music program to support it.

The volunteer schedule is 2 hours every Wednesday. There is a strong emphasis on music, instruments, voice, etc. Captain Manny mentioned Geneva retired music teacher Tom McClure as an invaluable volunteer who teaches brass instruments and piano.
