Program

Tonight's program was presented by **Michelle Colegrove**, Executive VP of Nursing & Medical /Services for **FLACRA**, Finger Lakes Area Counseling and Recovery. Their new site is located at 116 Lewis Street, Geneva, NY. There are offices throughout the Finger Lakes. They treat people with alcohol/substance abuse. Focus is on the whole person and treating people of all ages. They offer temporary PCP services, and in-patient and outpatient services. They also have a methadone clinic on site. They dispense methadone for pain management, and they taper patients off gradually. There are currently 680 patients they are serving in Geneva. Each Rotary member was left with a box of Narcan. It can be used for anyone that has overdosed on opioids. Always call 911 before administering it. It is a temporary fix.
