## **PROGRAM**

Ethan Fogg introduced **Anne Bateman, Executive Officer of Lochland School**, as our presenter today. Highlights of her presentation include:

- Lochland’s Mission is to create opportunities for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities to celebrate independence and encourage success.
- Six state-certified and supervised individual Residential Alternatives and one supported living apartment (a new residence on Norwood Avenue will house younger adults)
- Community Habilitation Service focuses on pre-employment skills and community integration activities and support. This service is largely provided in community settings and through volunteer placements, supported in a ratio of one staff for every four participants.
- There are currently 24 residents; 33 day program participants and 70 staff members. The oldest resident is in their 70’s; youngest in their 20’s.
- Lochland was founded in 1933 as a private school under the auspices of Mrs. Florence Stewart. She served as Lochland’s Executive Director for over fifty years until her death in 1983.
- Stewart House was built in the mid 1800’s and is also noted in the New York State Register of Historic Places as a meeting place for the Geneva area’s suffragettes and as a possible stopping point on the Underground Railroad.
